



> Laying on a land of 153,000 sqm, the particularity of the site in terms of location, topography, and views was the leading guide to the project's concept. The master plan was designed to respond to the site's characteristics as a destination while maintaining the privacy of the residents. Hence, a central core was created, that will articulate the hotel, some retail and entertainment uses as well as optional furnished apartments uses that can be operated by the hotel or separately.











> The village of Rachana, located north of Lebanon is a museum-like village that comes to life with modern sculpture made of wood, stone, granite, or metal. Situated at a 300m altitude, Mr. Rabih Abdallah's villa is surrounded by a magnificent view overlooking the Lebanese coast horizon from one side and the Rashana Green Valley from the other. Its modern architectural type, composed of large openings overlooking the sea view and tiled by two types of white stone and wood louvers, makes it a true work of art.

> The two elegantly rising towers decorating the Beirut City line, overlook an area of 5345 sqm of the Mediterranean Sea. More than 150 additional car parking space and 4000 sqm of landscaped area are available. Moreover, 22 floors of luxury residential apartments with duplexes on the top two floors are characterized by their simple and modern design, and by the delicate treatment of noble materials of glass, metal and stone cladding.





> Designing this project posed by itself many questions that we designers face everytime we have to deal with all the real world criteria that stands in the way of our dreams; i.e. from dealing with the client needs and demands, to the budget and areas built, the construction laws. I truly believe that we designers are doomed!

What I like about this project is that although it answers to all the needs of the client, the built-up area required, the permit and construction laws, not ideal from the budget side maybe, but definitely worth the extra leverage it demands, but this project also answers to the small need inside every architect to express himself, by going slightly outside the box, and laying out a design that is a bit unique and challenging especially from the construction point of view. Another point worth mentioning is the age we live in, the age of technology, the era of the internet, humanity faces lots of changes, such as the collapse of the concept of distance. The concept of the printed book is on the way to its own demise as well, being replaced by the eBook, as a result of a merger between our environmental concerns, technology at hand, and cost control.





> Architecture however cannot deteriorate due to this movement; man's need for shelter will always remain. Architectural design however has been affected, and although we still start with a sketch, since sketching still remains the fastest means of translating and expressing our thoughts, feelings and ideas, the development of our designs today cannot but be affected by technology, the computer input to the design equation has allowed us to come up with limitless complexity in free forms, definitely unattainable with a paper and a t-square, and has given us the ability to construct them with complete precision, as is the case with the project at hand.





CREDIT LIBANAIS: THE CONCEPT



A curved glass wall lies behind the main structure, concealing the parking and technical spaces, and acting as a backstage reflecting the life and the energy within the building, while the space in between this wall and the tower will be the social interaction heart of the project. Photo voltaic cells occupy the southern façade compensating for part of the energy used by the building, and house under them a roof garden which will act as the green soothing extension to the cafeteria. The project will also incorporate an array of sustainable systems to be defined at a later stage.








A SMALL **GESTURE** AS A SYMBOL OF **GRATITUDE**


