














Name Ludwig Mies Van Der Rohe

While still designing traditional neoclassical homes, Mies made a series of pioneering projects, culminating in his two European masterworks: the Barcelona Pavilion (1929) and Villa Tugendhat in Brno, Czech Republic, (1930).

His significant projects in the U.S. include in Chicago and the area: the residential towers of 860-880 Lake Shore Dr, the Chicago Federal Center complex, the Farnsworth House, Crown Hall and other structures at IIT; and the Seagram Building in New York. These iconic works became the prototypes for his other projects.

Mies also designed modern furniture that have become popular classics, such as the Barcelona chair and table, the Brno chair, and the Tugendhat chair. His furniture is known to be a mix of traditional luxurious fabrics like leather combined with modern chrome frames, and a distinct separation of the supporting structure and the supported surfaces.


