

We committed to share this information with our stakeholders publishing the report on our Web portal and the UNGC website for free consultation, to assure our long term commitment to said principles.




Change begins with the leaders

Participants engage at the global level, and at their national or regional level. To start, a commitment from the CEO to meet fundamental responsibilities in four areas: Human Rights, Labour, Environment & Anti-Corruption is required with support from the Board. Then, a required **yearly financial contribution**, is made based on their annual revenue.

Accountability also matters

Then, they must voluntarily pledge to:

- Operate responsibly, in alignment with universal sustainability principles
- Take actions that support the society around
- Commit to the effort from their organization's highest level, pushing sustainability deep into their DNA
- Report annually on their ongoing efforts with a Communication in Progress
- Engage locally where they have a presence





TO BRING THEIR COMMITMENT TO LIFE

All participants are asked to:

- Make the UN Global Compact and its principles an integral part of their business strategy, day-to-day operations and organizational culture;
- Incorporate the UN Global Compact and its principles in decision-making processes at the highest levels;



As architectural company, waste generated is limited to paper, foam boards, cardboards, small water plastic bottles and old computers and peripherals (scanner, printers,....).

For all these types of recyclable waste, we contact related NGOs more specifically Arc-En-Ciel (AEC) and L'Ecoute Organization.

This year we disposed more than 100 computers with servers, printers and scanners that were in the store. They were divided between AEC and L'Ecoute. They refurbish them and re-sell them or recycle their material and the benefit goes to the NGO employing people with special needs. 10 tonnes of papers were also disposed from the store for the benefit of L'Ecoute organization.

In addition, we have an initiative to reduce the use of paper transforming our forms to e-forms.

Work Insurance is covering as well all accidents occuring at work.

ERGA FIRST AID KIT & AUTOMATIC EMERGENCY DEFIBRILLATOR available in the Logistics office for emergencies. Erga periodically trains interested employees on first aid basics to have in each floor trained personel and trained all support staff on using the defibrillator when needed.

SPORTS ACTIVITIES are continually supported by Erga. Erga participates in Beirut Marathon supporting yearly a cause and participates in Beirut Corporate Games competing for 2 days with other companies.
